

# Al-Ikhlas Centre Parent – Student – Teacher Learning Agreement<sup>1</sup>

## Student's Agreement

- I will adhere to the class dress code (boys: Thawb girls: Abayah and Hijab)<sup>2</sup>
- I will arrive on time for classes, preferably 10 minutes before time.
- I will bring to class the tools I need to learn (Quran, pen, pencil, paper and book).
- I will pay attention in class and not disturb others.
- I will show respect for teachers and fellow pupils.
- I will come to class prepared to learn.
- I will respect the sanctity (sacred nature) of the Masjid area.
- I will follow all school and classroom rules.
- I will do my best at all times.
- I will not leave the Masjid area between 5 to 7pm without telling and/or making my teacher aware of it.
- I understand that I may face exclusion from classes if I am issued with a written warning.

## Parent's Agreement

- I will drop off and pick up my children on time
- I will avoid causing traffic congestion and creating unnecessary neighbourly friction when picking up my child.
- I will be prepared to spend 30 to 60 minutes weekly on homework and Qur'an memorisation/revision at home.
- I will be involved in the on-going progress of my child by maintaining close coordination with the teacher.
- I will encourage and support my child's efforts to learn and to provide him with a quiet time and place to study.
- I will be responsible for the regular and prompt attendance of my child.
- I will support the classroom rules and I will teach my child to respect the rights and property of others.
- I will encourage my child's Islamic education and learning.
- I will set a good example for my child to follow.
- I understand that my child/applicant may face exclusion if found violating the class rules and regulations.

## Teacher's Agreement

- I will communicate with the student and parent at regular intervals.
- I will provide the highest quality of instruction possible.
- I will seek to be an Islamic role model inside and outside of the classroom.
- I will encourage the student to do his or her best work.
- I will require promptness and regular attendance.
- I will enforce all rules fairly and firmly.
- I will maintain a well-managed classroom.
- I will report any unIslamic conduct to the parent and expect the parent to resolve such conduct.
